Over the past twelve years, Empowering Women for Excellence Initiative has worked with a wide variety of staff members and interns who have shown exceptional skills in their areas of work. EWEI as a leader in the development of leaders of change has also seen the dire need for improved skills in various areas of the non-profit space.

To this end, EWEI and Global Young Generation For Peace Development Initiative (GFP Nigeria) are collaborating on a Monitoring, Evaluation and Accountability Incubator Programme.

The programme, which will host two female interns in its first year, is designed to help beneficiaries gain key technical skills in the area of monitoring, evaluation and accountability and support the development of interns in social entrepreneurship. Benefits of the programme include:

- Transportation costs covered on a monthly basis
- Experience and exposure to global practices in monitoring, evaluation and accountability
- Recommendation letter and certificate on satisfactory completion of the programme
- Potential for employment
- Mentorship

The EGIP duration is for six months with expected attendance on 3 office working days from 0900 – 1600 (21 hours a week) and additional activities days as assigned. The scope to be covered in this period include;

- Data collection; baselines, endlines, pre and post tests
- Data processing using tools from MS Word, MS excel, Vizzlo app, Survey Monkey
- Activity reporting
- Online capacity building
- Research and study
- Data analysis using tools from MS Word, MS excel, Vizzlo app

To be considered for EGIP, all candidates must:

- Have a high commitment to learn and grow
- Have completed a degree or diploma in a higher institution
- Have interest in research and analysis
- Be committed to the duration of the programme
- Be a woman
